AN ACT RELATIVE TO LICENSING PROVISIONS OF THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 17 of Chapter 23B of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by Section 3 of Chapter 541 of the Acts of 1974, is further
3 amended by adding to subsection (a) (i) after the words "or classes
4 of buildings and structures and parts thereof;" the following: "; the
5 licensing provisions of this section shall not apply to one and two
6 family structures built in conformance with the state building
7 code."
