RESOLVE AUTHORIZING THE STATE TREASURER TO PAY FOR CERTAIN HIGHWAY WORK AUTHORIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That, notwithstanding the provisions of any special or
2 general law to the contrary there shall be allowed and paid from the
3 highway fund, subject to appropriation, the sum of sixty-three
4 thousand, seven hundred and twenty dollars and ninety cents to the
5 Flint-Kote Company of Massachusetts, assignee of the Campa-
6 nella Corporation of Rhode Island, for certain paving work per-
7 formed in the town of Oak Bluffs upon request of the department
8 of public works in May of nineteen hundred and seventy-three. No
9 payment shall be made hereunder until there has been filed with the
10 treasurer and agreement signed by said company that the amount if
11 any paid or to be paid for legal services rendered in connection with
12 the passage of this act shall not exceed ten percent of said sum.
