Ordered, That the Legislative Research Council is directed to conduct an investigation and study relative to the financial impact on the consumer, taxpayer, industry and government of business and government compliance with regulatory rules and regulations promulgated by state administrative agencies. Said Council shall report the results of its investigation and study by filing a report thereof with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before the second Wednesday of February in the year nineteen hundred and eighty.
