AN ACT PERMITTING SCHOOL COMMITTEES OR BOARDS OF TRUSTEES FOR VOCATIONAL EDUCATION TO CHARGE TUITION FEES TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN A PROGRAM LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF ASSOCIATE IN APPLIED SCIENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 37A of chapter 74 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by section 3 of chapter 268 of the
3 acts of 1967, is hereby further amended by adding the following
4 sentence: —

5 Tuition fees in an amount approved by the commissioner of
6 education may be charged to students enrolled in a program lead-
7 ing to the degree of Associate in Applied Science offered by any
8 such school.
