The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Nine.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF PREPAID MONTHLY PASSES FOR USE ON MASS TRANSIT FACILITIES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat
2 its purpose, which is to immediately provide for wider distribution
3 of pre-paid mass transportation passes, therefore it is hereby
4 declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
5 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 167 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting
2 after section 69 the following new section: —
3 *Section 70.* Any bank, as defined in Section one of this chapter,
4 or any credit union, as defined in Section one of Chapter 171 of the
5 General Laws is hereby authorized, subject to agreement entered
6 into with the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority, or any
7 regional transit authority established pursuant to the provisions of
8 Chapter 161B, to sell pre-paid monthly passes for use on the
9 facilities of the Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority or
10 said regional transit authorities.
