By Mr. Brennan, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 87) of John A. Brennan, Jr., for legislation to regulate cigarette advertisements displayed on Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority vehicles and facilities. Commerce and Labor.

AN ACT REGULATING CIGARETTE ADVERTISEMENTS DISPLAYED ON MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION VEHICLES AND FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 161A of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after Section 29, the following section: —
- 3 *Section 30.* No person shall display on any train, bus, trolley,
- 4 station or other vehicle or facility of the Massachusetts Bay
- 5 Transportation Authority any advertisement for cigarettes.
- 6 Any person who violates this section shall be subject to a fine
- 7 of not less than 10 (ten) nor more than fifty (50) dollars.
- 8 Each day's display of such advertisement on said train, bus,
- 9 trolley, station or other vehicle or facility of the M.B.T.A.
- 10 shall constitute a separate violation of this section.
