AN ACT MAKING CONSISTENT THE PROCEDURES FOR APPEALS OF  
UNEMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION DECISIONS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 69c(c) of chapter 151A of the General Laws is
- 2 hereby amended by adding the following sentence: —
- 3 Any person aggrieved by a decision of the Director that
- 4 recovery of an overpayment not be waived shall have the
- 5 right to appeal such decision in accordance with the pro-
- 6 visions set forth in sections thirty-nine to forty-two of this
- 7 chapter, inclusive.
