AN ACT RELATIVE TO STATE AID FOR THE NORTH SHORE REGIONAL VOCATIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE SCHOOL BUILDING ASSISTANCE LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The North Shore Vocational Regional School District shall  
2 be eligible for state aid under the provisions of Section Nine A  
3 of Chapter Six Hundred and Forty-Five of the Acts of Nine-  
4 teen Hundred and Forty-Eight as if the existing lease between  
5 the said regional school district dated February Nineteenth,  
6 Nineteen Hundred and Seventy-Six and the USM Community  
7 Realty Corporation had been executed on or after July First,  
8 Nineteen Hundred and Seventy-Eight. The amount of reim-  
9 bursement shall be determined by adding together the remain-  
10 ing rental due under said lease as of July 1, 1979 and the  
11 entire cost of initially equipping and furnishing the leased  
12 building or buildings. Said reimbursement shall be paid annu-  
13 ally in equal parts by dividing the total of such reimbursement  
14 by the number of years during which the lease will remain  
15 outstanding from the effective date of this act, the first pay-  
16 ment to begin in the fiscal year commencing on July First,  
17 Nineteen Hundred and Eighty and such payments shall be  
18 made from any funds appropriated for grants and reimburse-  
19 ments under the provisions of Chapter Six Hundred and Forty-  
20 Five of the Acts of Nineteen Hundred and Forty-Eight; pro-  
21 vided that any amounts received in any year by the regional  
22 school district under the save-harmless provisions of Chapter  
23 Seventy of the General Laws which are attributable to ex-

24 penses incurred by the district under the existing lease shall  
 25 be deducted from each respective annual payment under this  
 26 act.
