By Mr. Parker, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 366) of Joseph L. Amaral, mayor, (with the approval of the municipal council) for legislation to authorize the city of Taunton to submit to the Secretary of State the plan redividing the wards in said city. Election Laws.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF TAUNTON TO SUBMIT TO THE STATE SECRETARY THE PLAN REDIVIDING THE WARDS IN SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The city of Taunton is hereby authorized to
2 submit to the state secretary a plan redividing wards one and
3 seven in said city as adopted by the municipal council of
4 said city on November 20, nineteen hundred and seventy-nine
5 and approved by the mayor of said city on November 20,
6 nineteen hundred and seventy-nine, notwithstanding the pro-
7 visions of section one of chapter fifty-four of the General
8 Laws. In all other respects, said city shall comply with the
9 provisions of said section one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
