The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE SECRETARY OF ENERGY TO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS AND STANDARDS FOR CERTAIN ENERGY-CONSUMING APPLIANCES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The secretary of energy is hereby authorized
2 and directed to promulgate regulations and standards concern-
3 ing the manufacture, sale and use of all energy-consuming ap-
4 pliances sold or transported in or into the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January first,
2 nineteen hundred and eighty-two.

17. The State shall have a further responsibility to provide for the health and safety of its citizens. It shall have the authority to regulate the business of energy in Pennsylvania and to regulate and control the production and distribution of energy in Pennsylvania.

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

In the Year of the Lord 1978 and 1979

18. Notwithstanding the authority or right to regulate the production and distribution of energy in Pennsylvania, the Commonwealth shall not regulate the production and distribution of energy in Pennsylvania.

19. The Commonwealth shall not regulate the production and distribution of energy in Pennsylvania, except as provided in this article.

20. Section 1. The authority of energy is hereby transferred to the Commonwealth. The authority to regulate and control the production and distribution of energy in Pennsylvania shall be transferred to the Commonwealth.

21. Section 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 1980.
