**AN ACT INCREASING THE NUMBER OF FORENSIC DENTISTS IN
THE COMMONWEALTH.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 38 of the General Laws as appearing in Chapter
- 2 829 of the Acts of 1975 is hereby amended by striking sec-
- 3 tion 1A and inserting in place thereof the following section:—
- 4 The Governor shall appoint for the term of seven years
- 5 such numbers of persons he deems necessary skilled in forensic
- 6 dentistry as forensic dental examiners who shall assist any
- 7 medical examiner or associate examiner when requested to do
- 8 so. For the purpose of this section a “forensic dental exam-
- 9 iner” shall be a dentist capable of assisting a medical examiner
- 10 or associate medical examiner in a medico-legal investigation.
