

SENATE No. 600

By Mr. Aylmer, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 600) of John F. Aylmer for legislation relative to the transportation of persons attending certain facilities of the Department of Mental Health. Human Services and Elderly Affairs.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSPORTATION OF PERSONS ATTENDING CERTAIN FACILITIES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 19 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 28 and inserting in place
3 thereof the following new section: —

4 *Section 28.* Whenever a mentally retarded person qualifies
5 for attendance at an educational, habitational or day care
6 program or facility of the Department of Mental Health,
7 and said person is not eligible for services under the provisions
8 of chapter seventy-one B, the department shall provide for
9 the transportation of said person to and from such facility on
10 such days as it is in session.

1 SECTION 2. Section thirteen of chapter seventy-one B of the
2 General Laws is hereby repealed.
