AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOLUNTARY ADMINISTRATION OF ESTATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 16 of Chapter 195 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out lines two and three and inserting in
- 3 place thereof the following: —
- 4 of personal property the total value of which may include
- 5 motor vehicles of which the decedent was the owner, the
- 6 value of each motor vehicle not to exceed seven thousand five
- 7 hundred dollars at the time of the decedent's death, and other
- 8 personal property not exceeding two thousand

An Act to amend the Constitution of the State of New York

The Constitution of the State of New York and the laws of the State of New York shall be amended in the following manner:

1. Section 11 of Chapter 111 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out from said section and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
 - i. of personal property the full value of which shall be subject to taxation of which the decedent was the owner, the value of such personal property shall be ascertained from the personal return in the form of the decedent's death and other
 - ii. personal property not shown on such return
