By Mr. Rotondi, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1128) of Samuel Rotondi and Catherine A. Fallon for legislation to provide incentives for cities and towns to budget monies for management training for newly elected municipal officials. Local Affairs.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING INCENTIVES FOR CITIES AND TOWNS TO BUDGET MONIES FOR MANAGEMENT TRAINING FOR NEWLY ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 the commonwealth shall provide on a material basis for the
3 purpose of obtaining suitable and proper management train-
4 ing for newly elected municipal public officials or newly
5 elected school committee members, an amount of money not
6 to exceed \$100 per official.

7 Said Reimbursement shall be equal to that amount said city
8 or town spends on said training, provided however, the com-
9 monwealth's matching portion shall not exceed \$100 per offi-
10 cial. Provided further that the commonwealth shall provide
11 these matching funds for a maximum of four officials per city
12 or town per year.
