1 *Resolved*, That the Department of Environmental Manage-
2 ment is hereby authorized and directed to make an investiga-
3 tion and study to determine the feasibility of the Common-
4 wealth assisting the Town of Newbury and the City of New-
5 buryport with financial aid in the maintenance of the public
6 beaches at Plum Island.

7 Said Department shall, in the course of its investigation,
8 examine the use of the beaches by non-resident population,
9 the violation of beach rules and regulations, the cost to said
10 Town and said City of lifeguard salaries, equipment, litter
11 removal, and other such matters as the Department deems
12 necessary.

13 Said Authority shall report to the General Court the re-
14 sults of its investigation and study, and its recommendations,
15 if any, together with the drafts of legislation necessary to
16 carry such recommendations into effect by filing same with
17 the clerk of the Senate on or before May first nineteen hun-
