SENATE No. 1308

By Mr. Aylmer, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1308) of John F. Aylmer for legislation to provide that a certain physical condition or disease resulting in total or partial disability or death to county correctional officials and certain members of the Barnstable County Sheriff's Department shall be presumed to have been suffered in the line of duty with reference to the accidental disability law. AN ACT PROVIDING A CERTAIN PHYSICAL CONDITION OF DISEASE RESULTING IN TOTAL OR PARTIAL DISABILITY OR DEATH TO COUNTY CORRECTIONAL OFFICIALS AND CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE BARNSTABLE COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT SHALL BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN SUFFERED IN THE LINE OF DUTY WITH REFERENCE TO THE ACCIDENTAL DISABILITY LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 94 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in chapter 610 of the acts of 1963, is hereby amended by in-
- 3 serting after the word "airport," the words: — The sheriff,
- 4 master, deputy master, assistant deputy master, and correc-
- 5 tion officers of county correctional facilities, members of the
- 6 criminal investigation bureau and drug information bureau
- 7 of the Barnstable County Sheriff's Department.
