AN ACT RELATIVE TO VETERANS PREFERENCE IN CIVIL SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Clause forty-third of Section 7 of Chapter 4 of the General  
2 Laws as most recently amended by Chapter 156 of the Acts  
3 of 1976 is hereby further amended by adding the following:—  
4 or (3) any person who had made a binding commitment  
5 to active service in the armed forces of the United States on  
6 or before May seventh, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
