SENATE No. 1339

By Ms. Buckley (by request), a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1339) of Arthur Ford for legislation to provide that employees in Group 1 of the public retirement system be compelled to retire at age sixty-five. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT EMPLOYEES IN GROUP 1 OF THE PUBLIC RETIREMENT SYSTEM BE COMPELLED TO RETIRE AT AGE SIXTY-FIVE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1 of chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the definition of "Maximum Age", as
- 3 appearing in section 1 of chapter 826 of the acts of 1967, and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the following definition: —
- 5 "Maximum age", the age on the last day of the month in
- 6 which any member classified in *Group 1, Group 2, or Group 4,*
- 7 as provided for in paragraph (g) of subdivision (2) of section
- 8 three attains age sixty-five, or if classified in *Group 3* attains
- 9 age fifty-five.
