AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEDICARE DEDUCTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary,
2 or any rule or regulation promulgated by any agency of the
3 commonwealth to the contrary, Whosoever has payments de-
4 ducted from retirement benefits for payment from medicare
5 may have this deduction ceased if this deduction is being made
6 from another retirement benefit plan. It is the responsibility
7 of the retiree to inform the retirement if such action is re-
8 quested.
