**AN ACT ALLOWING HAROLD STONE TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE
MASSACHUSETTS CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any special or General Laws to the
2 contrary, Harold Stone shall not be prevented from joining
3 the State Employees Retirement System, "System" as de-
4 fined in section one of chapter thirty-two of the General
5 Laws, because of his age; provided that he shall pay into the
6 annuity savings fund of the System the makeup payments, if
7 any, required by chapter thirty-two of the General Laws.
