Sheehan, executive secretary, and Francis X. McCann for legislation to provide certain funds for adequate staffing and operation of the Contributory Retirement Appeal Board. Public Service.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE CERTAIN FUNDS FOR ADEQUATE STAFFING AND OPERATION OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT APPEAL BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (4), Section 16 of Chapter 32 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by adding the following: —

3 For the purposes of providing adequate staffing and expan-
4 sion of the Contributory Retirement Appeal Board, and in
5 order to alleviate certain conditions now existing, there shall
6 be for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1980 only, an assess-
7 ment of \$1,000 levied against each Retirement Board in the
8 Commonwealth thereafter to be supported by a prorated fee
9 per case per Board.

10 The above-mentioned funds to be designated exclusively for
11 the use of the Contributory Retirement Appeal Board and to
12 be placed in trust and administered by representative trustees
13 selected from the retirement boards throughout the Common-
14 wealth.

15 The above funds to be included as part of the annual appro-
16 priation as designated by the Actuary of the Division of In-
17 surance.
