AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONTINUED PAYMENT OF COST-OF-LIVING TO ANY ELIGIBLE BENEFICIARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Paragraph (a) of section 102, of chapter 32 is hereby
- 2 amended by inserting the following words: nothing in this
- 3 section shall prevent the continued payment of Cost of Living
- 4 to any eligible beneficiary of a deceased retiree.
