AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT IN RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES, PENSIONS AND ANNUITIES OF RETIRED EMPLOYEES AND OTHER BENEFICIARIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 102 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 19 of Chapter 487 of the Acts
3 of 1978, is hereby amended by striking out the words "and
4 shall submit such determination to the general court by filing
5 a report with the clerk of the house of representatives" in the
6 first sentence of paragraph (a); the words "as the general
7 court shall determine" in the second sentence of paragraph
8 (a); and the words "as the general court shall determine" in
9 the first sentence of paragraph (e).
