AN ACT RAISING THE AMOUNT OF A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT UNDER WHICH A BIDDER IS EXEMPT FROM THE STATE FINANCE LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 8B of Chapter 29 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out the final paragraph and inserting in
3 place thereof the following section: —

4 “This section shall not apply to any prospective bidder the
5 aggregate amount of whose work with said Department of
6 Public Works or with said Metropolitan District Commission
7 including his proposal, is less than (new) One Hundred and
8 Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000).”
