

SENATE No. 1629

By Mr. Doris, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1629) of Francis D. Doris for legislation to provide for a change in the eligibility age for real estate abatements for the elderly from seventy years of age to sixty-five years of age. Taxation.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE ELIGIBILITY AGE FOR REAL ESTATE ABATEMENTS FOR THE ELDERLY FROM SEVENTY YEARS OF AGE TO SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 To Amend Chapter 59, Section 5, Clause 41, of the General
- 2 Laws which is "An Act Providing for Real Estate Abatements
- 3 for the Elderly over 70". This will be amended by striking out
- 4 the age 70 and inserting in place thereof the age 65, and
- 5 copies be sent to our legislators after passage.
