**AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXING OF INCOME.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 4 of chapter 62 of the general laws as most re-
- 2 cently amended by section 41 of chapter 684 of the acts of
- 3 1975 is hereby amended by adding the following sentence: —
- 4 Persons who are over the age of sixty-five and whose income
- 5 from all sources is twenty thousand dollars or less shall be
- 6 taxed at the rate of five percent.
