## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT REQUIRING A REVIEW OF UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATIONS FINANCED BY BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

The governor shall review all unexpended appropriations 2 made on or before June thirtieth, nineteen hundred and sev-3 enty-nine which are financed in whole or in part by a bond 4 authorization pursuant to Article LXII of the Amendments to 5 the Constitution of the Commonwealth. Said review shall con-6 sider the following: (a) whether there have been any changes 7 in the physical needs of the commonwealth reflecting different 8 policy or programmatic objectives, (b) the financial ability 9 of the commonwealth to support any increased operating ex-10 penditures resulting from the completion of the projects; and 11 (c) the additional debt service resulting from issuance of the 12 bonds. The governor shall transmit a recommendation to the 13 general court on or before April fifteenth, nineteen hundred 14 and eighty-one, detailing which appropriations and bond au-15 thorizations, previously authorized but unexpended, should be 16 either reduced or repealed. Said recommendation shall include 17 a statement of the reasons for either continuing, reducing or 18 repealing appropriations and bond authorizations.
