SENATE No. 1885

By Mr. Hunt, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1885) of Robert M. Hunt for legislation relative to the annual allowances to organizations and units of the armed forces of the Commonwealth. Ways and Means (Joint).

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ANNUAL ALLOWANCES TO ORGANIZATIONS
AND UNITS OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws is hereby amended by strik-
2 ing out section 97, as most recently amended by chapter 370 of
3 the acts of 1960, and inserting in place thereof the following
4 section: —

5 *Section 97.* There shall annually be allowed and paid quart-
6 erly from money appropriated for the purpose in such amounts
7 and at such times as may be determined by the adjutant gen-
8 eral pursuant to such regulations as may be promulgated by
9 the commander-in-chief, to the organizations and units of the
10 armed forces of the commonwealth, when not in federal serv-
11 ice, for administration and maintenance, including postage,
12 printing, office and other necessary supplies not available
13 through issue, for athletic or recreational equipment for the
14 use of enlisted personnel, for clerical assistance, for the repair
15 and alterations of uniforms, and such other military purposes
16 as may be approved by the commander-in-chief of said regula-
17 tions.
