RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF RONALD J. HOYT.

1 *Resolved*, That for the purpose of discharging a moral obli-  
2 gation of the commonwealth, there shall be allowed and paid  
3 out of the state treasury, subject to appropriation, to Ronald  
4 J. Hoyt of Methuen, the sum of one hundred dollars in pay-  
5 ment for the amount paid by him in settlement of a claim  
6 made against him as the result of an action made by him in  
7 the line of his duty as a supervising hearings officer in the  
8 department of the Registry of Motor Vehicles.
