1 *Ordered*, That the Committee on Natural Resources and
2 Agriculture be authorized to sit during the recess of the Gen-
3 eral Court for the purpose of making an investigation and
4 study of the subject matter of current senate document num-
5 bered, 1208, providing for comprehensive enforcement of cer-
6 tain laws relating to marine fisheries and fish.

7 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the State-
8 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may require by sum-
9 mons the attendance and testimony of witnesses, may travel
10 within and without the commonwealth and may expend for
11 expert, legal, clerical and other services and for expenses such
12 sums as may be appropriated therefore.

13 Said committee shall report to the general court from time
14 to time the results of its investigation and study and its recom-
15 mendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary
16 to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same
17 with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the
18 first Wednesday of December nineteen hundred and eighty.
