**AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE REGISTRATION FEE
FOR THE REGISTRATION OF SANITARIANS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 87MM of Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking out the words "fifteen dollars" in the last
- 3 sentence of the first paragraph, and inserting in place thereof
- 4 the following words: — Thirty-five dollars.

Section 1000 of Chapter 112 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "S. 1000" in the first sentence of the first paragraph and inserting the words "S. 1000" in the following words:— "This act shall take effect on the 1st day of July 1903."
