By Mr. McGrail, a petition (accompanied by resolve, Senate, No. 522) of Stephen J. McGrail that provision be made for an investigation and study by a special commission (including members of the General Court) of the General Court of the feasibility of requiring certain welfare recipients to work for the city or town in which they reside as a condition of receiving welfare assistance. RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION OF THE FEASIBILITY OF REQUIRING CERTAIN WELFARE RECIPIENTS TO WORK FOR THE CITY OR TOWN IN WHICH THEY RESIDE AS A CONDITION OF RECEIVING WELFARE ASSISTANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of repre-
3 sentatives, and two persons to be appointed by the governor,
4 is hereby established for the purpose of making an investiga-
5 tion and study of the feasibility of drafting and filing legisla-
6 tion requiring all welfare recipients who are determined to be
7 employable by the department of welfare to work for the city
8 or town in which the welfare recipients reside as a condition
9 for receiving welfare assistance.
