**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

**AN ACT ESTABLISHING THE FIFTEEN TERRITORIES FOR CLASSIFICATION OF RISK UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE LAW.**

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to reestablish forthwith the fifteen  
3 territories for classification of risk under the motor vehicle  
4 insurance law, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emer-  
5 gency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the  
public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of law,  
2 rule or regulation, the commissioner of insurance is hereby  
3 authorized and directed to reestablish the same fifteen terri-  
4 tories for classification of risk under the motor vehicle in-  
5 surance law in existence on January first nineteen hundred and  
6 seventy-three.

1 SECTION 2. The motor vehicle insurance rates effective for  
2 the year 1974 shall remain in effect for the year 1975. Any  
3 motor vehicle insurance rates promulgated by the insurance  
4 commissioner for the year 1975 are hereby voided.
