AN ACT TO REESTABLISH THE AUTHORITY OF THE ROXBURY DISTRICT COURT OVER JUVENILE MATTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 76 of the General Laws is
2 hereby amended by striking out the third sentence, added by
3 section 1 of chapter 241 of the Acts of 1947, and inserting in
4 place thereof the following sentence: —

5 The Boston Juvenile Court shall have jurisdiction, concur-
6 rent with the Municipal Court of the City of Boston, of com-
7 plaints hereunder.

1 SECTION 2. Section 62 of chapter 119 of the General Laws
2 as appearing in section 9 of chapter 731 of the Acts of 1972
3 is hereby amended by striking out in lines 6 and 7 the words,
4 “the municipal court of the Roxbury district.”

1 SECTION 3. Section 63 of chapter 119 of the General Laws
2 as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition is hereby amended
3 by striking out, in line 18 the words “and the municipal court
4 of the Roxbury District.”
