AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE FILING FEE OF WILLS FOR SAFEKEEPING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 191 is hereby amended by striking out section 10
- 2 and inserting in place thereof the following section: —
- 3 *Section 10.* A will enclosed in a sealed wrapper, with an en-
- 4 dorsement thereon of the name and residence of the testator
- 5 and of the day when and the person by whom it is deposited,
- 6 and with or without the name of a person to whom the will is
- 7 to be delivered after the death of the testator, shall, on the
- 8 payment of fifteen dollars, be received by the register of pro-
- 9 bate in the county where the testator lives, who shall give a
- 10 certificate of the receipt thereof, and shall keep such will; and
- 11 the same shall not be opened until it is delivered to a person
- 12 entitled to receive it or is otherwise disposed of as hereinafter
- 13 provided.

By Mr. Tamm: A motion is made to amend the bill as follows: To strike the word "and" after the word "and" in the first line of the first section and insert the word "or" in its place.
