AN ACT RELATED TO THE DETERMINATION OF INDIGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 261, Section 27A of the General Laws is hereby
- 2 amended by striking paragraph three and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following: — "Fees and costs", fees and costs shall
- 4 include attorneys' fees.
