Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

3 striking out in the fourth paragraph the line reading "District
4 Court of Lowell" and in the seventh paragraph by inserting
5 after the line reading "Central District Court of Worcester"
6 the following; — District Court of Lowell.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ADDITIONAL JUDICIAL DISTRICTS IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF IOWA.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Iowa in Session assembled and by the authority of the people as follows:

1 Section 10 of chapter 218 of the General Laws of Iowa is hereby amended by adding in chapter 148 of the code of Iowa to be read as follows: "Chapter 148 striking out in the fourth paragraph the words 'Central District Court of Iowa' and in the seventh paragraph by inserting 'Central District Court of Iowa' after the words reading 'Central District Court of Iowa'." and the following:— District Court of Iowa.
