AN ACT DESIGNATING MARCH SEVENTEENTH AS A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws is hereby amend-
- 2 ed by striking out clause Eighteenth, as most recently amended
- 3 by section 1 of chapter 493 of the acts of 1974, and inserting
- 4 in place thereof the following clause: —
- 5 Eighteenth, "Legal holiday" shall include January first, Jan-
- 6 uary fifteenth, July fourth and Christmas day, or the day fol-
- 7 lowing when any of said days occur on Sunday, and the third
- 8 Monday in February, March seventeenth, the third Monday in
- 9 April, the last Monday in May, the first Monday in September,
- 10 the second Monday in October, November eleventh and Thanks-
- 11 giving day. "Legal holiday" shall also include, with respect to
- 12 Suffolk county only, June seventeenth or the day following
- 13 when said day occurs on Sunday.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Twenty-Six

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA

Enacted by the Senate and Assembly of the State of California at the
 Court assembled and by the authority of the same, on January 15, 1926.

- 1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the Statutes of the State of California, as amended,
- 2 and by striking out clause (b) thereof, shall read as follows:
- 3 By section 1 of chapter 403 of the acts of 1924, and reading
- 4 in place thereof the following clause:—
- 5 "Sightings of 'legal holidays' shall include January first, the
- 6 day of March, July fourth and Christmas day, or the day for
- 7 following when any of said days occur on Sunday, and the third
- 8 Monday in February; March recesses, the third Monday in
- 9 April, the last Monday in May, the first Monday in September,
- 10 the second Monday in October, November eleventh and thirteenth
- 11 of every year; 'legal holidays' shall also include, with respect to
- 12 public employes only, such recesses as the day following
- 13 when said day occurs on Sunday.
