AN ACT MAKING CERTAIN CORRECTIVE CHANGES IN THE LAW ESTABLISHING THE LANCASTER SEWER DISTRICT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 831 of the Acts of 1967, as amended by Chapter  
2 659 of the Acts of 1970, is hereby further amended by insert-  
3 ing after Section 4 the following new section:—  
4 *Section 4A.* Said board of sewer commissioners, acting for  
5 and on behalf of said district, may take by eminent domain  
6 under Chapter 79 of the General Laws, or acquire by purchase  
7 or otherwise, any lands, water rights, rights of way or ease-  
8 ments, public or private in the town of Clinton, necessary for  
9 accomplishing any purpose mentioned in the above referenced  
10 Acts; provided, that said takings must be no further than  
11 2,500 feet from the Lancaster-Clinton town line, and be re-  
12 stricted to a 20 foot wide permanent easement with appropri-  
13 ate working easements. Nothing in this section shall super-  
14 cede or conflict with the right of the Metropolitan District  
15 Commission to take said easements as provided in Chapter 462  
16 of the Acts of 1954.
