AN ACT REQUIRING CITIES AND TOWNS TO PUBLISH CERTAIN
INFORMATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general special law to the contrary
2 cities and towns shall publish annually the following informa-
3 tion: — (1) a total of all federal and state funds allocated to
4 the city or town (2) the offices, departments, bureaus, agencies
5 or authorities to which such funds were distributed and the
6 amount there of (3) the amount of local funds allocated to
7 each office, department, agency bureau of authority (4) the
8 aggregate of federal state and local funds allocated to each
9 office, department, agency, bureau and authority and (5) the
10 total number of employees within each office, department,
11 bureau, agency and authority.
