AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME FOR EMERGENCY OPERATION  
OF A SCHOOL BUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Clause (4) of Section 7B of Chapter 90 of the General Laws
- 2 is hereby amended in line 6 by striking out the word "three"
- 3 and inserting in place thereof the word "fourteen".
