AN ACT CLARIFYING AWARDS UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE
COLLECTIVE BARGAINING LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The ninth paragraph of section 4 of Chapter 1078 of the
2 Acts of 1973 as amended by Chapter 121 of the Acts of 1975
3 is hereby further amended by striking out the second sentence
4 and inserting in place thereof the following sentence: — Any
5 award of the arbitration panel may be retroactive to the be-
6 ginning of said municipal finance year.
