AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE WORKING CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH AND ITS POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any provisions of Chapter 150E of the

- 3 litical subdivisions shall have the right to strike.
