AN ACT DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF ESTABLISHING A TOLL FREE TELEPHONE SYSTEM FOR CITIZENS TO CALL STATE AGENCIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Secretary of Administration and Finance is hereby
- 2 authorized and directed to study the feasibility of establishing
- 3 a system of toll-free telephone service for the citizens of the
- 4 Commonwealth to call state agencies. Said secretary shall re-
- 5 port the results of said study, including recommendations for
- 6 necessary legislation, if any, by the first Wednesday in Decem-
- 7 ber, 1976.
