RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF CORPORATIONS AND TAXATION RELATIVE TO THE OPERATION OF CHAPTER EIGHT HUNDRED AND FORTY-NINE OF THE ACTS OF NINETEEN HUNDRED AND SIXTY-NINE RELATING TO THE FISCAL CYCLES OF COUNTIES, CITIES, TOWNS AND CERTAIN DISTRICTS.

1 *Resolved*, That the Department of Community Affairs and
2 the Department of Corporations and Taxation are hereby au-
3 thorized and directed to make an investigation and study rela-
4 tive to the operation of chapter eight hundred and forty-nine
5 of the acts of nineteen hundred and sixty-nine and amendments
6 thereto relating to the fiscal cycles of counties, cities, towns
7 and certain districts. The secretary of administration and fi-
8 nance shall designate a director of the study and shall assign
9 the responsibility for various aspects of the study to the above-
10 named departments. Said departments shall report to the
11 general court the results of their investigation and study, and
12 their recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legisla-
13 tion necessary to carry such recommendations into effect, and
14 shall file their report with the clerk of the senate on or before
15 the fifteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and seventy-
16 six.
