Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law
- 2 to the contrary, any owner or operator of a motor vehicle that
- 3 is driven on state highways for less than twenty percent of its
- 4 total mileage shall receive a rebate of two cents per gallon of
- 5 gasoline for the balance of said total mileage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TAXATION OF CERTAIN PERSONS WHO RECEIVE A REBATE ON THE GAMBLING TAX.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Conference on the 11th day of February, 1914.

SECTION 1. That the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, any contract or agreement of a minor vehicle that it is to be used for other purposes for less than twenty percent of its total mileage shall receive a rebate of two cents per gallon of gasoline for the mileage of said total mileage.
