AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE AN OFF RAMP FROM THE NEW BEDFORD-FAIRHAVEN BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The provisions of any general or special law to the contrary
- 2 notwithstanding, the department of public works is hereby
- 3 authorized and directed to construct and operate an off ramp
- 4 from the New Bedford-Fairhaven Bridge, directly connected
- 5 to Frontage street in New Bedford, for the purpose of provid-
- 6 ing a natural route for south-end-bound traffic.
