AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITIES AND TOWNS TO REMOVE CERTAIN
OBSTACLES WHICH ARE DEEMED OBSTRUCTIONS TO SIGHT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The cities and towns of the commonwealth are hereby au-
- 2 thorized and directed to remove any tree, shrub, edifice, or
- 3 other thing, either natural or manmade, which is deemed, by
- 4 the police, highway, or public works department of said cities
- 5 and towns, to be an obstruction to the sight of a motor vehicle
- 6 operator.
