AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO PROVIDE FOR INFORMATION FACILITIES AND COMFORT STATIONS ALONG MAJOR STATE HIGHWAYS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The department of public works shall provide for motorist
- 2 information service facilities and comfort stations for the con-
- 3 venience, necessity and safety of the traveling public along all
- 4 major state highways at distances not exceeding ten miles.

By Mr. Wall, a motion was proposed by Bill Senate, no. 1185, of 1911, that Mr. Wall be appointed to the Department of Public Works to provide for information, facilities and comfort stations along major state highways.
