The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE ARLINGTON POLICE RELIEF ASSOCIATION TO PAY A CERTAIN BENEFIT TO ITS MEMBERS UPON THEIR RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The Arlington Police Relief Association, Inc., a corporation
- 2 duly established under the laws of the Commonwealth, is here-
- 3 by authorized, upon retirement from the Police Department of
- 4 the Town of Arlington of any member in good standing, to pay
- 5 to such member, if he so elects, the sum of one thousand dol-
- 6 lars, of the death benefit paid upon the death of such mem-
- 7 ber in good standing as may from time to time be determined
- 8 by a vote of said corporation.
- 9 Any amount so paid shall reduce the death benefit otherwise
- 10 payable upon the death of any such member.
